Rotary's PolioPlus Campaign Receives Execulink's Annual Holiday Donation

Woodstock, ON – December 7, 2015 – Execulink Telecom handed over their annual holiday donation to Rotary International's PolioPlus campaign, the goal of which is to immunize the world's children against polio.

Ian Stevens, Execulink's CEO (left), presented Ted Beynen, President of the Woodstock Rotary Club (right), with a cheque for \$6,600.

This donation will be matched 2-1 by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation as well as the Canadian Government, which means every dollar from this donation, will immunize 5 children. Execulink's total donation will immunize roughly 33,000 children worldwide.

Execulink's donation is part of their Holiday Giving campaign, a tradition for the Telecommunications provider during this time of year.

Rotary launched the PolioPlus program in 1985. Since then, nearly seven million children have escaped the threat of polio because of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. Due to the efforts of Rotary and its global partners, reported polio cases have dropped 99% and the world is on a threshold of eradicating the disease.

"With Execulink's generous donation, we are one step closer to meeting our goal of eradicating Polio worldwide," exclaimed Beynen.
